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During the course of the term, pupils will be taught to:

- Swim unaided for a sustained period of time over a distance of 25m;
- Use recognised arm and leg actions, lying on their front and back;
- Pace themselves in floating and swimming challenges related to speed, distance and personal survival;
- Use a range of recognised strokes and personal survival skills, for example front crawl, back crawl, breaststroke, sculling, floating and surface diving;
- Learn about water safety.

Children will be assessed at the start of the programme by qualified instructors and placed in appropriate groups for their level of swimming ability.

To enable us to support the swimming programme, we are asking for voluntary contributions of \pounds 32.50 for the cost of Autumn Term lessons, which at a cost of \pounds 2.50 per lesson I'm sure you will agree is fantastic value for money. This can be paid in a one off payment or in two instalments of \pounds 16.25 each half term.

If you wish to pay a one off payment, please select the Swimming Lesson 2019 item on ParentPay and enter a **£32.50 payment by Friday 6th September.**

If you wish to pay in two instalments, please select the Swimming Lesson 2019 item on ParentPay and enter a £16.25 payment by Friday 6th September and the final balance of £16.25 by Monday 28th October.

You are also able to pay by bank transfer, the bank account details are: Lloyds Bank, Account No. 42802368, Sort Code 30-90-76. Please use your child's name and 'swimming' as a reference.

Lessons for Pupil Premium children will be subsidised by the Pupil Premium grant and therefore no payment is required for these pupils.

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SWIMMING LESSON GUIDELINES

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Girls - One-piece costume - NO BIKINIS

Boys – Trunks or swimming shorts (should be above the knee length) NO BERMUDA SHORTS.

All – All children will be required to wear a swimming hat and will have one issued free of charge on the initial visit to Sidcup Leisure Centre. Subsequent and replacement hats can be purchased for £1.00 from the Centre or alternatively children can provide their own thereafter (**long hair must be tied up underneath the swimming hat**).

Children will need:

A towel A brush or comb A bag for wet costume/towel

No deodorants or hair gel are allowed and costumes must **NOT** be worn under clothes for quick changing otherwise they will have no dry underwear to change into.

No jewellery at all must be worn, including earrings. **Goggles** can be worn at parents' discretion.

Should your child have a verruca, it must be treated and they should wear a verruca sock; available from sports shops or chemists.

If for some reason your child is unable to go on a specific week, please send a note in to inform the teacher otherwise they will have to attend the swimming lesson.
