Please make payment via ParentPay where possible. If you require log in details for this please contact the school office.

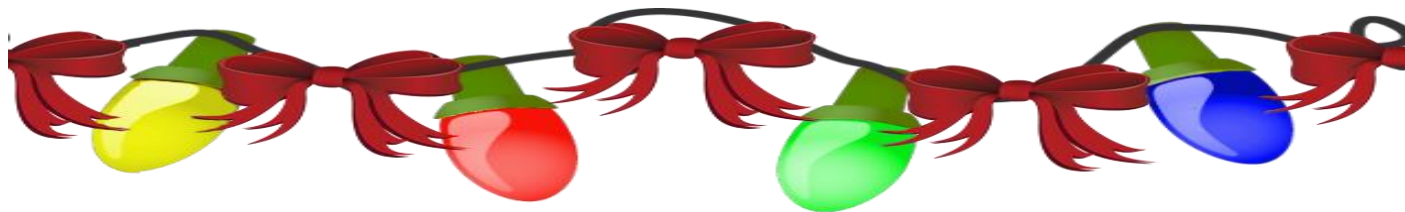
