Year 4/5 - Creators Autumn Term 2024

Science

Year 5 students will be learning about different forces in our world, including water and air resistance and gravity.

Year 4 students will be learning about light, how it travels, shadows and reflections.

Homework will be set as a menu of activities that children can complete over the term. These activities will be a range of presentations, activities to explore the outdoors and writing tasks.

Spellings will be sent home on Mondays and a quiz will be given on Fridays. Please practice these at home with your child.

Send these in Tuesdays and/or Thursday.

English

We'll be focusing on writing a narrative story, including speech and descriptive language. We'll also use the information we learn in geography about our oceans to write persuasively.

PE

We will be swimming this term! Please come to school in your PE kits on Fridays. Bring your swimming costume, a towel and goggles (if needed). Don't forget a plastic bag to put your wet clothes in. Our other PE day will be Thursday. Please come to school in your PE kit and wear black trainers.

History and Geography

We'll be exploring why our oceans matter, how we use them, how they've changed over time and how humans can affect them.

Maths

We will be focusing on place value then use this to work on addition and subtraction. We will be focusing on reasoning skills.

RE

We'll spend some time learning a parable Jesus taught and share it with the school. Then we'll discuss the question: Just how important are our beliefs? We'll discuss other religions including Christianity.

Creative and Expressive Arts

We will be learning how to improve our drawing this term. We'll learn how to hold the pencil differently for different effects, learn how to create contrast and use patterns in new ways.

PSHE:

We'll be looking at different types of relationships we have. We'll think about manners and how we can have a positive impact on those around us.
