Daily Tasks:

Reading- 20 minutes of reading a day. Please record this in the reading record so we can celebrate the children's efforts. A simple signature and page number is perfect! Book change days- Tuesdays and Thursdays.

TimesTables- 10 minutes a day on times table rockstars.

Spellings- Weekly spellings will be sent home on a Monday and a quiz will take place on Friday.

Then, write at least a paragraph describing your new creature. Remember to use similes and metaphors! *E.g this is a Gronk. His eyes are as bright as a dazzling diamond. Your children will have a small maths pack with sheets like the one below. These are all topics we have covered previously in class or will be covering this term. If your child isn't sure of anything, it may be that we haven't covered it yet. If this is the case, they can leave it and revisit it once we have learnt about it
