Spellings- Weekly spellings will be sent home on a Monday and a low stakes quiz will take place on Friday. 😊

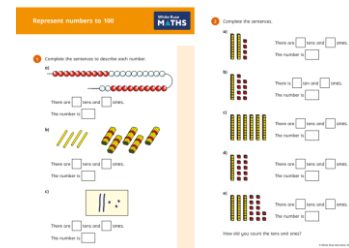
English:

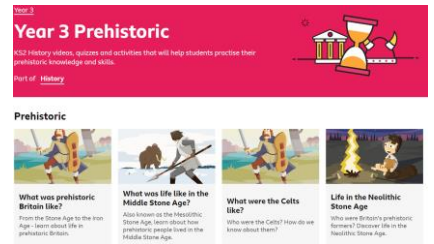
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Create a poster all about magnets, try to include some objects you use at home or at school that you think may or may not be magnetic.
