

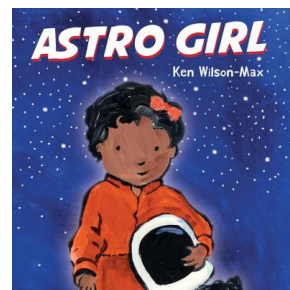
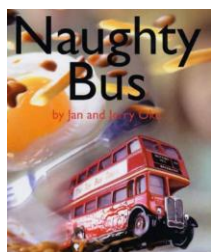


## Class name: Trailblazers Spring 2 2025-26



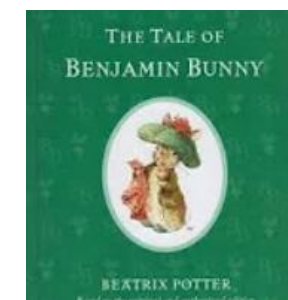
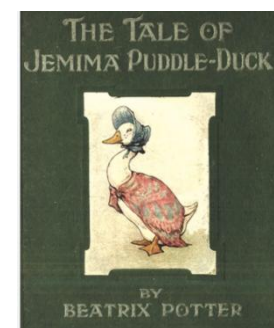
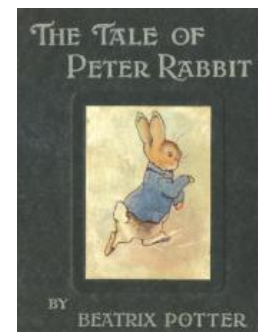
### English:

Some of our texts this half term include The Great Race, Train Ride, The Naughty Bus, Astro Girl.



### Home learning:

Reading records need to be returned every **Tuesday and Friday**. Please record a comment about what they have read. Please ask them questions to support their comprehension of what they've read. Children should read at least 3 times in a whole week.



### Maths:

The children will continue to develop their counting skills and explore the concept of parts and wholes. We will be looking at symmetry and linking this to doubles and exploring the composition of odd and even numbers.

### Author of the term:

Our author of the term is Beatrix Potter. We will be exploring books such as Peter Rabbit, Jemima Puddle-Duck and Benjamin Bunny.

### Understanding the world:

The children will be exploring forces and seeing which materials help a toy car travel faster down a slope. We will also be looking at maps and map making as well as looking at our school from above.

### RE:

The focus for this half term in RE is exploring what makes the world around the children special, learning why the world can be special to both themselves and others. We will also be learning about the Easter story.

### Expressive arts and design:

Children will develop and practise threading and weaving techniques using various materials and objects. They will look at the history of the bookmark from Victorian times versus modern-day styles. The children apply their knowledge and skills to design and make their own bookmarks.

### PSED:

In this unit, children will learn how to look after their wellbeing through exercise, a balanced diet and care for themselves.
