



English:

We will study *Discovering Sutton Hoo* as a report and *Banksy: Artist or Vandal?* as a discussion text, developing children's skills in presenting facts, sharing opinions, and giving reasons.

Mathematics:

Both year groups will learn about fractions. Year 3 will also study mass and capacity, while Year 4 will focus on decimals

Science: We will enjoy a visit from a scientist during science week and some exciting experiments.

RE:

Children will explore the question, "Who was Jesus really?" and learn about his life, teachings, and why he is important to Christians.

Learning beyond the classroom: We will be visiting Woodlands Farm this term, learning about where our food comes from.

Home learning: Please practise spellings with your children. Times Tables Rock Star needs to be done daily for 10 minutes. Read with your child daily for 20 minutes and turn in reading records on Friday.

Author of the term: We will be reading books by David Walliams, whose funny and adventurous stories are popular with children and help build a love of reading.

History/Geography:

We will explore the question, "What changed in Britain after the Anglo-Saxon invasion?" and learn how life, settlements, and culture developed during this period.

PE:

We will explore golf and tennis, developing coordination, control, and teamwork through structured physical activities.



Computing:

We will learn about Online Safety: Online Bullying, focusing on how to stay safe, be kind online, and deal with unkind behaviour. In NCCE: Stop Frame Animation, children will create simple animations using digital tools.

Art/DT:

Children will explore Mechanical Systems: Mechanical Cars, learning how simple mechanisms and structures work to create movement in a model vehicle.

Music:

Children will explore Haiku, music and performance through the theme of Hanami, learning how to express ideas, mood, and imagery through sound and creative presentation.

PSHE:

Children will focus on Economic Wellbeing, learning about money, saving, spending, and making sensible choices.
