English: We'll be writing narrative and recount texts. We'll continue to practise GPS skills and guided reading.

Maths: Geometry - looking at measuring angles and plotting coordinates.

Science: We'll be learning about lifecycles of plants and animals.

RE: We'll be answering the question: Why are some places in the world significant?

Learning beyond the classroom: We'll be visiting a local mosque on 15/4/26, which is part of the Bexley RE syllabus. We will not be participating in a service, just looking at a mosque and seeing how it differs from other religions.

We'll do a local trip to visit the River Cray on the 20 of May to support out science curriculum.

Also, complete TTRS at least 10 minutes a day to make maths easier for your child.

Author of the term: We will be reading the exciting spy book written by Anthony Horowitz : Alex Rider.

History/Geography: We'll be looking at where our energy comes from.

PE: Come to school in PE kits Mondays and Thursdays. We'll be playing cricket on the field.

Computing: Online safety will focus on online bullying. We'll also look at video production.

Art/DT: Depth, emotion and movement in our drawings
