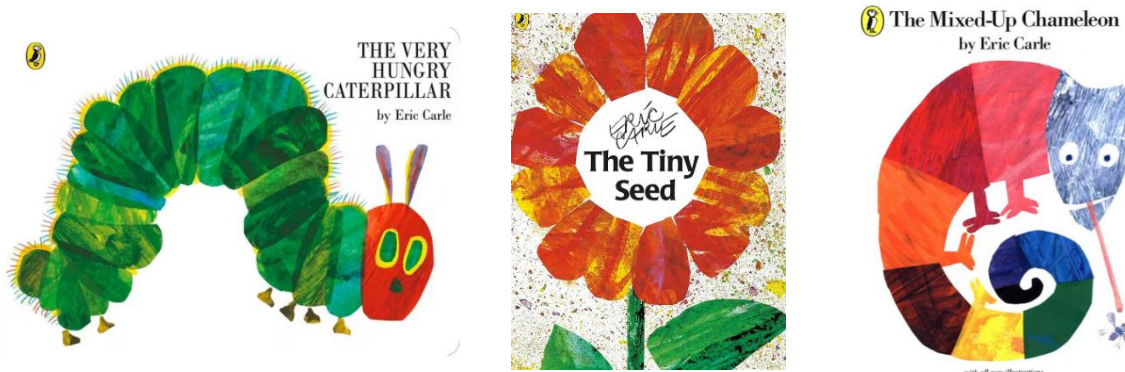
English:

Some of our texts this half term include Rainbow Fish, Sharing a Shell and Commotion in the Ocean. We will be working on writing simple words and phrases that can be read by others. We will also continue to focus on letter formation.



Home learning:

Reading records need to be returned every **Tuesday and Friday**. Please record a comment about what they have read. Please ask them questions to support their comprehension of what they've read. Children should read at least 3 times in a whole week.



Expressive arts and design:

Children will learn about the different features of boats and ships before investigating their shape and structures to build their own.

We will learn what makes a musical instrument, the four different groups of musical instruments, following a beat using an untuned instrument.

Maths:

In Maths we will continue to focus on our deeper understanding of the numbers to 10. We will be using Rekenreks to explore numbers and will also continue to explore shape, space and measures through manipulating shapes and consolidating our understanding.

PSED:

This half term we will be reviewing everything we have learned this year and focusing on transition to Year 1.

Author of the term:

Our author of the term is Eric Carle. We will be exploring books such as The Hungry Caterpillar, The Tiny Seed and The Mixed Up Chameleon.

RE:

This half term we will be discussing favourite stories and exploring why some stories are special to other people.

Understanding the World:

We will be exploring some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries, drawing on knowledge from stories, non-fiction texts and maps.

We will be having forest school on Tuesday – please send children in wearing PE kits with wellies and waterproofs in a bag.

PE:

Our focus will be practising for sports day. We will also work on learning and playing some team sports.
