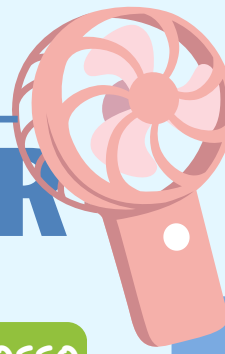

(Psalm 118:14)

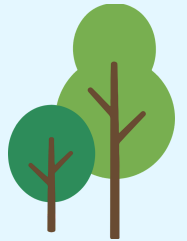
