English:

Some of our texts this half term include Funnybones, The Colour Monster and The Three Little Pigs. We will explore vocabulary that we can use in our speaking. We will also start using our phonics scheme Little Wandle to learn some initial sounds.

Maths:

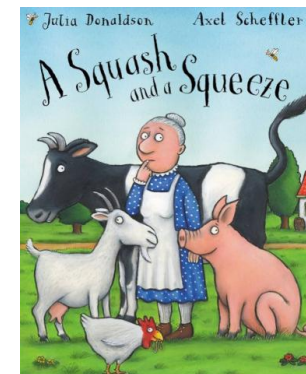
We will be focusing on the composition of numbers to 5 and developing our subitising skills (recognising amounts without counting).

Understanding the world:

In Understanding the World, children will talk about their families and the people who are special to them. They will also explore autumn and notice how the world changes with the seasons.

Home learning:

Reading records need to be returned every **Tuesday and Friday**. Please record a comment about what they have read. Please ask them questions to support their comprehension of what they've read. Children should read at least 3 times in a whole week.



Author of the term:

Our author of the term is Julia Donaldson. We will be exploring books such as 'The Oak Tree', 'Gozzle' and 'A Squash and a Squeeze'.

RE:

Our unit this half term is called "Why is the word God so important to Christians?" Children will explore Christian beliefs about God and creation, and begin to understand why God is so important to Christians.

Expressive arts and design:

In EAD, children will sing familiar songs and rhymes while exploring sounds, colours, textures and different ways of making art. They will also develop their imagination through pretend play, creating props and simple storylines.

PSED:

In PSED, children will learn to understand and express their feelings, become more independent and follow classroom routines. They will build positive relationships, learning to share, take turns and recognise how others are feeling.
