**Time: 8:15am – 8:50am every school day**

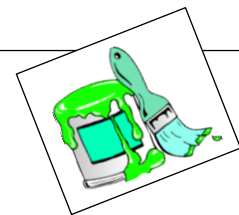
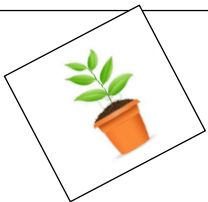
**Place: School Hall**
