DONATED FOOD PROGRAM

As part of our community work, we have partnered with two local organisations who will be providing us with **free food** three times per week during term time for parents and friends of Hope Community School. This is food that is fit to eat which the supermarkets would be disposing of that day so it helps them to reduce their waste and gives us the opportunity to offer the food to you free of charge.

The food will be available between 3pm and 4pm on Mondays, Tuesdays and Fridays outside the school office or in the Community Room. Please note that we can't guarantee that the food will be available every Monday, Tuesday or Friday as there may be some days when collection isn't possible.

We will be collecting the food from Morrison's on Monday and from Tesco (through the organisation FareShare) on Tuesdays and Fridays.

It is most likely to be bakery goods and fruit and vegetables but some days there may be other food items such as canned goods or toiletries.

We will be trialling this scheme as a help yourself service but we will begin managing the scheme and directing it to those in need if we find that they are not getting the chance to access the food. Please think about other parents/carers who may have a greater need for the food and just take what you really need.
