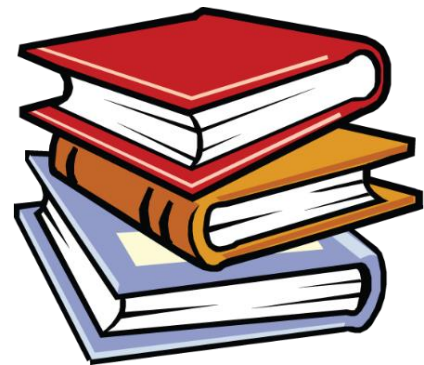


Do you have any old (clean) adult shirts that you no longer wear? We are trying to collect a stock for children to use during their art lessons.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Dropping off your children

As mentioned in Friday's Newsflash, we have become aware of children being dropped off at the external school gate by their parents – one child even as young as 5!

Your children remain your responsibility until they are directly passed to the class Teacher/TA.

Dangerous Driving

Please be mindful when driving to and from school and making turns in Rectory Lane. The pavements are narrow, there are vehicular driveways and there are of course two busy schools in the immediate area.

Adult Language

Please ensure that appropriate language is used, even when outside the school premises, in front of children.

Medication in School

If your child requires medication in school, you will need to complete and sign the school's 'Medication to be administered' form. If you are not dropping them off, please send in a signed note authorising us to administer it to them. We will only administer prescription medication if your child requires 4 doses. If your child needs 3 doses, this can be dealt with at home i.e. before school, straight after school and at bed time. Only medication that has been prescribed by a Doctor or Chemist is allowed in school.
