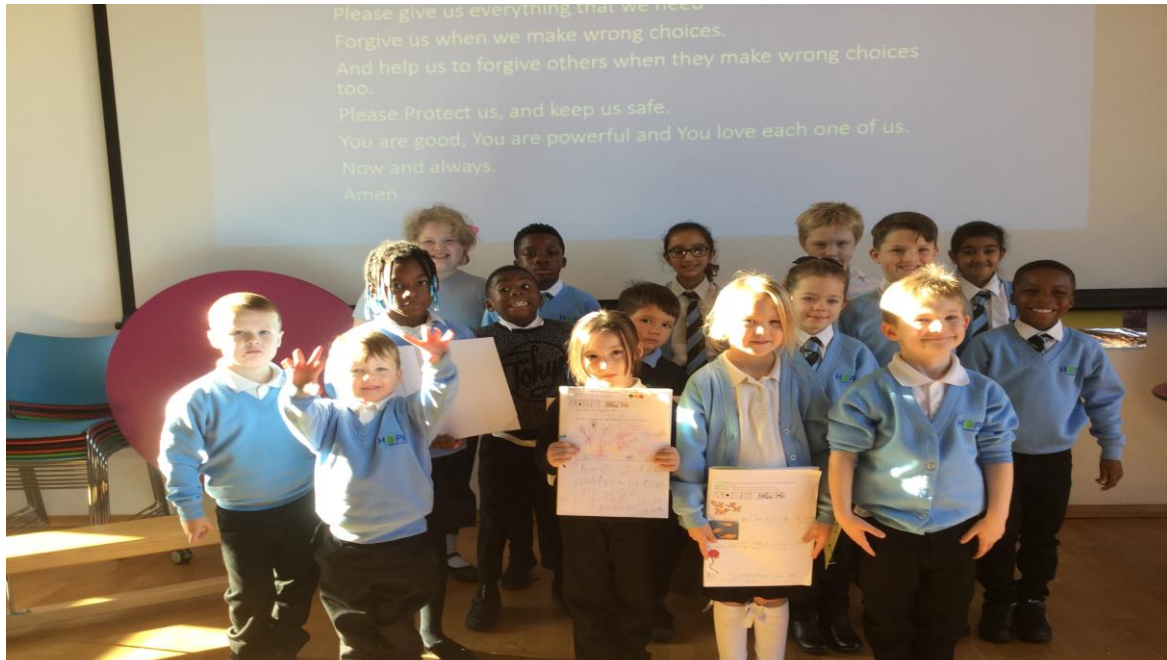

Packed lunches and Birthday treats



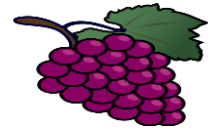

Here is a reminder ...

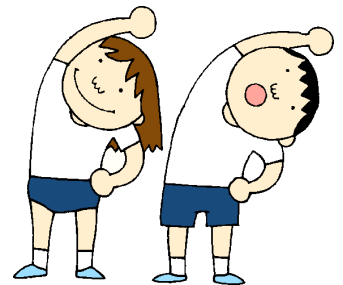
Reception Class
